# **Bad for Maine Families**



50,000 Mainers could lose health coverage and see their premiums go up

Wealthy families get a tax break of \$4,000 per child while low-income families only get \$75 per child



189,000 Mainers who rely on SNAP food benefits would see cuts



# **Bad for Maine Small Businesses**

The corporate tax rate gets nearly cut in **HALF**, but



86% of small businesses 80% of the small wouldn't even benefit from the top rate cut for small businesses

business tax break would go to millionaires

## **Bad for Maine Seniors**



A 64-year-old Mainer would see premiums increase on average \$1,750 per year

**50+** 3 out of 4 tax
